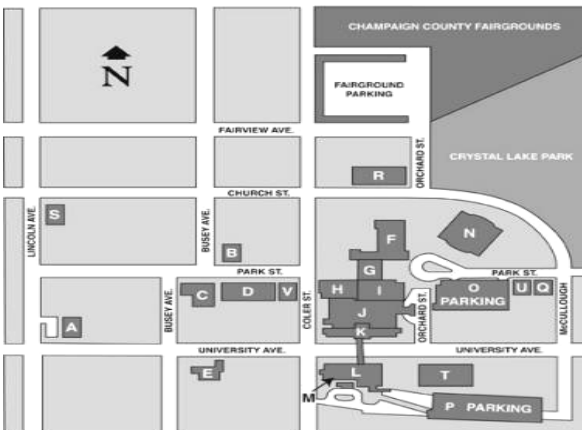
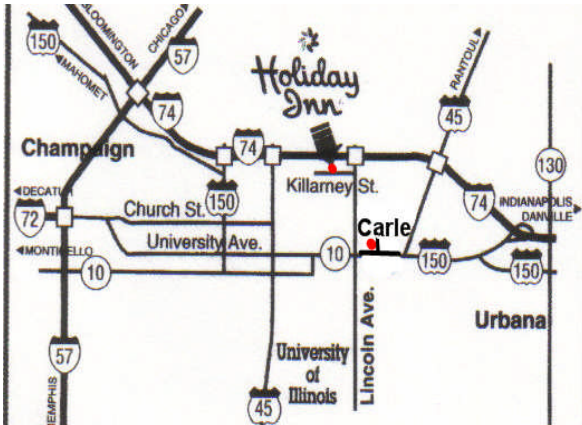


## Directions and Lodging
